Here are the two options for leaving on Wednesday, July 13, 2016 and enjoying a "getaway" of two-nights/three-days, bus transportation, lodging, two dinners (up to \$25/each), fees/taxes paid based on double occupancy:

- Washington D.C. Marriott Springhill Suite 2 free breakfasts plus 2 dinners, night monument tour, Arlington, Smithsonian or shopping, *Phantom of Opera* performance @ Kennedy Center, National Archives, and National Zoo = ~\$700-750/person
