



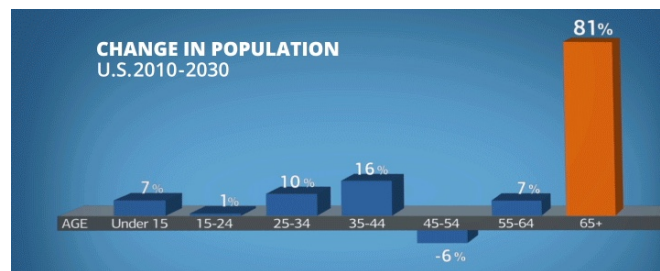

- One out of every three Americans has no retirement savings whatsoever.
- Over 40% of single seniors 65-and-over get at least 90% of their income from Social Security
- Only 51% of Americans are confident they're saving enough
- More than 1/3 of Americans expect to work in retirement.
- 60% of older Americans fear outliving their savings
- Almost 60% of retirees don't budget for leisure activities when planning for retirement.
- The average healthy couple will spend \$337,000 on healthcare in retirement.

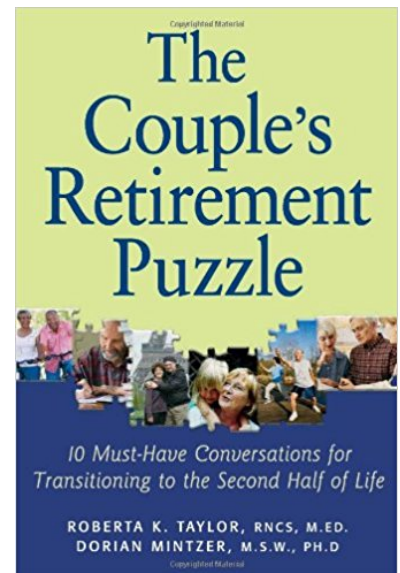
