## Retired Member Coordinator Goals

PMEA State President Dennis Emert (2014): "The purpose of the Retired Member Coordinator is to utilize PMEA retired members in a variety of ways, keeping them active and involved in PMEA."

- 1. Organize annual meeting of retired members at In-Service Conference

- 4. Serve as a communications person for retired members
- 5. Serve on the TTRR Council, attend state board meetings when invited by the state president



## The Retiree Resource Registry

Based on PMEA Retired Members' online survey responses, the <u>Retiree Resource Registry</u> (R³) and R³ Help Index archive a comprehensive record of music teacher retirees' present and past job assignments, history of career achievements and awards, current professional music and music education activities, and special talents and interests. The registry serves as a "who's who" directory of past leaders in PA music programs, as it documents the amazing contributions of some of the still most active albeit retired members.

The R³ shares this vast wealth of the PMEA Retired Member experiences and expertise in order to offer the entire PMEA membership access to a list of very willing and capable informal advisers or consultants if anyone needs "free" (but priceless) help in any area.

## The Retiree Resource Registry

Start with the R³ Help Index to peruse possible candidates. To help match your needs with potential retired "go-to people," the index is sorted by volunteer subject areas. Look up these names in the alphabetical main registry to find the retirees' specific details, contact information, personal focus and specialties, and subjects they would be willing to provide assistance.
