Margaret S. Bauer Grant Program

Rolling Application Deadline

PMEA established this grant program in honor of former PMEA Executive Director Margaret Bauer.

The purpose of the program is to provide grants to qualifying PMEA members who require funding for professional development, teaching resources, equipment, or creative projects which will enhance music instruction and student learning and further the mission of PMEA.

Applicants must be a current active PMEA member and have been a member for at least one year prior to the grant request. If selected for a grant, the recipient will submit a report to the committee within thirty days of completion of the professional development or project and write an article for PMEA News based on the results. If the grant is awarded for resources or equipment the report will include examples of how they were used in the recipient's classroom. Members are eligible to apply for one grant every five years and if a request is denied it may be resubmitted the following year.

The maximum amount awarded for a single grant will be \$1000. Grant money may not be used for transportation or hotel costs associated with conference attendance. An interview may also be part of the selection process. Recipients will be announced at the Annual In-Service Conference.
