We ask for your assistance in helping/reminding the student(s) to complete these forms.

- 3. Incomplete or late submissions, failure to return the Contract, Emergency Medical Care Form, and/or payment will constitute the need to replace the student.

The 2019 NAfME All-Eastern Honors Jazz Ensemble will perform in the Spirit of Pittsburgh Ballroom at the David L. Lawrence Convention Center on Saturday, April 6, 2019, 7:30 p.m. along with the 2019 PMEA All-State Jazz & Vocal Jazz ensembles.

It is suggested that each student's school director/teacher accompany him/her to and from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. This person is encouraged to escort the student to the honors group's on-site registration and can be the adult point of contact for the student throughout the conference. On-site registration will take place from Noon - 2:30 p.m. on Thur. April 4 at the ensemble rehearsal location.

The \$595 participation fee includes registration, housing (double occupancy, 1 per bed), meals, and local transportation. It **does not** include transportation to and from Pittsburgh (nor from the airport into the city).

All groups will be housed at a designated Pittsburgh area hotel (see enclosed schedule). Music will be mailed to directors in January for distribution to students. We appreciate your assistance in helping your students follow through with the above items. The managers for the honors ensembles are excited to have outstanding guest conductors. (See contact information below.) This promises to be a wonderful musical experience for our Eastern Division students.
