Through their involvement with St. Paul's esteemed choir, Choral Scholars will have the opportunity to work with accomplished musicians on a weekly basis, perform a large volume of quality music at a very high level, and gain further proficiency in sight-reading and vocal confidence. Young singers will also gain insight into the requirements of being a professional musician.

Weekly Schedule

Thursdays: Rehearsal 7:30–9:30pm

Sundays: Choral Eucharist 11:00am (10:00am call)

and a monthly 5:00pm service (Choral Evensong, Lessons & Carols, etc.)

Compensation

\$25 per appearance (about \$1500 for the course of the year)

Other special services as scheduled, such as Christmas Eve and during Holy Week.

Conflicts with school calendars are negotiable.

A singing tour to England (cathedrals in London and Exeter) is planned for the summer of 2022.

Auditions for all voice parts will be held by appointment during July and August.
