10:30 am - 12:45 pm- Student Registration at Host School- East Stroudsburg HS- South The entrance you will use, which includes parking is located at the BACK of the School. (A MAP is included on the CONCERT BAND Ensemble page). Use VINE Street to go around the building and then park near the Band Hill. Enter by the entrance to the RIGHT of the Band Hill.

There will be East Stroudsburg HS- South students outside to DIRECT you to the BACK of the building. Please do NOT park in the front of the school on this day as those are bus dismissal spots. Directors are to register their students and distribute their student ID badges. The PMEA Nurse will check-in student medications.

*****STUDENT LUGGAGE OPTIONS*****

A. Luggage Truck will be at Host School/ Luggage remains in the truck until students return from their Host school, then will unload at Kalahari AFTER the Concert.

B. Directors keep student luggage in their vehicle until evening and then make arrangements with students to secure luggage from vehicles after the Thursday Evening Concert. (Students will sign out/in via Chaperones at Kalahari).

C. If Kalahari rooms are available and the Director has registered students, luggage may go to the room.

11:00 am - until evening at Kalahari Resort Student Lodging Registration (All Ensembles).

Directors are responsible for registering their students and obtaining room keys to distribute to them. Directors are to make arrangements with their students for a meeting location and time to dispense keys. (Examples- Kalahari Main Lobby or Host School). Also, all students will be attending the US Army Band Concert in the evening at Kalahari and will be seated in designated sections by Ensemble.
