



July 18-19, 2022 - DoubleTree Reading

PMEA is continuing its planning for the in-person 2022 Summer Conference, July 18 & 19 at the DoubleTree Reading hotel. In keeping with the policies established for its 2022 Annual Conference & All-State Festival, PMEA will require proof of full vaccination for all summer conference attendees at the time of registration. This policy will comply with all applicable laws and is based on guidance from the CDC and the PA Department of Health, as applicable.

Requesting a Medical or Religious Exemption:

For a Medical Exemption: A completed [Conference Medical Exemption Form](#) from the individual's medical provider is required and must be submitted via the [Conference Medical Exemption Form](#) (due Wed., July 6).

For a Religious Exemption:

A completed [PMEA Conference Religious Exemption Form](#) must be submitted by Wed. July 6.

*Please note that if an attendee previously received a medical or religious exemption for the 2022 PMEA Annual In-Service Conference they do **NOT** need to apply again.

**Individuals with an approved accommodation will be required, at a minimum, to comply with all other PMEA COVID-19 policies and protocols designed to mitigate the spread of the virus and safeguard community health and safety, including but not limited to COVID-19 testing, masking, physical distancing and other applicable preventive requirements that may be in place at the time of the Summer Conference. Additionally, those individuals with an approved exemption will need to submit a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours before arrival at the event, as well as bring with them one (1) home (rapid) test for on-site testing as requested.

*Fully vaccinated is defined as two doses of the Pfizer (ages 5+) or Moderna (ages 18+) or one dose of the J & J (ages 18+) vaccines.
