INTRODUCTION

HOW THE NEW SML WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN 2023

The PMEA Selective Music List (SML) for Band has been revised and is ready for implementation in 2023 at PMEA Music Performance Assessments (MPA's).

Directors are strongly recommended to select their music for this year's MPA's from this list at the grade levels designated. However, given that this is the first year of the new list and understanding that directors may have already selected music for this school year's MPA, music not currently on the list may be submitted for approval as in the past.

Complete and submit the 'Selective Music List Requests' online form to ask this and other common questions concerning repertoire to perform at an MPA, especially those that emerge while implementing a newly revised list. Those questions will likely include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Permission to perform a piece not currently on the Selective Music List. Pieces submitted will be considered for approval and assigned a PMEA Grade Level.
- Permission to perform fewer movements of a multi-movement piece at a lower grade level instead of the entire piece at the grade level listed. This opportunity expands flexibility for ensembles to perform one or more movements of a multi-movement piece at a lower grade level to expose more students to a piece that they might not be able to perform in its entirety at that time.
- Permission to perform other movements of a given piece than currently listed. The listing for some pieces already indicates specific movements to be performed at a designated grade level. Directors may propose changing the movements involved and the resulting grade level.
- Request to change the current grade level assigned to a given piece. Directors may propose that a given piece be reviewed for possible reclassification at a different grade level, lower or higher.

An ongoing goal will be to identify all the multi-movement pieces, review the scores, and determine what options are available for ensembles to perform fewer movements of the same piece but at a lower grade level. Enabling more pieces to be more accessible by more students is a feature of quality lists that we feel should also be a priority in Pennsylvania.

Also, please contact me with any corrections needed in content or spelling for any part of the list: titles, composers, arrangers, or publishers as well as if a given piece is now 'OOP'/Out of Print' or available only by 'Rental Only' or 'Print on Demand'.

A quality Selective Music List is one that is always an active 'work in progress', continuously evolving to reflect additions from previously published and new repertoire, refinements in number of movements required, additional listings with options to perform fewer movements of a given piece at a lower grade level, adjustments to assigned grade levels, and routine corrections for accuracy.

HOW THE BAND SML WAS REVISED

The existing PMEA Selective Music Lists for Band, Orchestra and Chorus were last revised in 1991. Developing the new PMEA Selective Music Lists included the following steps:

- Researched existing state and other recognized lists
- Set aside the existing PMEA SML from 1991 to use as a reference and started fresh with current lists
- Identified seven high quality selective music lists for Band to use as primary source documents: Florida, Kentucky, Maryland, National Band Association, New York, the Teaching Music Through Performance series, and Texas
- Acquired the most recent 'list' available from each source
- Developed an Excel spreadsheet layout and then converted or typed each of the seven source lists into the document to then be merged into one master compilation of almost 7,500 titles
- Proofed for spelling, added many first names of composers and arrangers, and standardized the data entry formatting
- Distilled the master compilation into a format listing each individual title and the rating that each piece received, if any, within each of the 7 source lists
- Added the pieces that were not already on the master compilation as submitted by directors and approved since 2004 by Dr. Tad Greig from Westminster College for use at PMEA MPA's, resulting in an initial total of 5,407 listings
- Determined an initial, official PMEA Rating for each title derived from the ratings each received, if any, within the seven source lists, taking into consideration that grade level assignments are not standardized among lists or by publishers. Grading criteria is mostly unavailable.

The official PMEA Band Selective Music List (SML) will be continuously provided as an Excel spreadsheet for maximum director flexibility in sorting and searching. We recommend perusing the list as sorted By Title; By Composer; By Grade and then by Title; and By Grade and then by Composer.

The initial 5,407 titles are divided into six Grade Levels as follows:

Subsequent steps planned concerning the PMEA SML for Band that have not already been mentioned include, but are not limited to, the following:

- To research and establish official PMEA criteria for assigning Grade Levels 1-6 to Band repertoire
- To develop a formal review process by a 'Band Repertoire Review Committee' to determine if submitted pieces should be approved to be added to the PMEA SML for Band and, if so, at what Grade Level.
- To review the last formal edition of the PMEA SML for Band in 1991 to determine if any pieces included that are not on the new PMEA SML for Band should be reinstated.

- To establish a network for borrowing a piece that is out of print from existing libraries throughout the state
- To identify which of the titles included in the PMEA SML for Band are indeed 'masterworks' or 'core repertoire' as an additional resource for new and veteran directors alike
